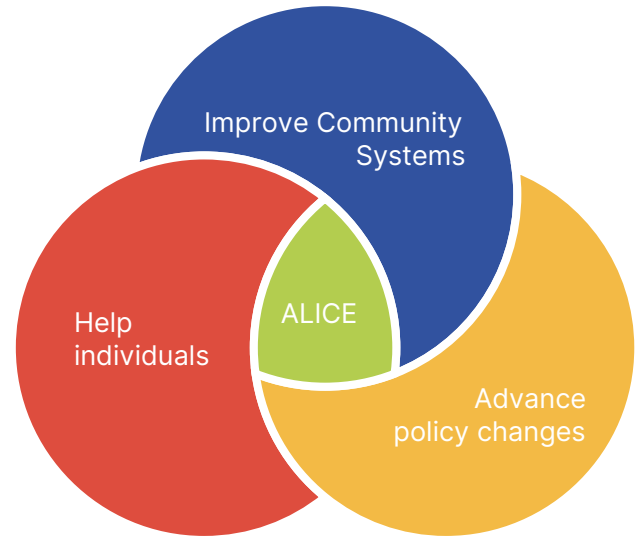




OUR MISSION
